The Dallas/Fort Worth National Cemetery was an expansion of an existing VA Cemetery. Much like our Florida National Cemetery project, this expansion included 34 acres of earthwork and the installation of 15,000 pre-cast burial vaults. All necessary infrastructure and utilities were constructed along with a new committal shelter and the above ground columbarium to receive 4,000 cremated remains.
