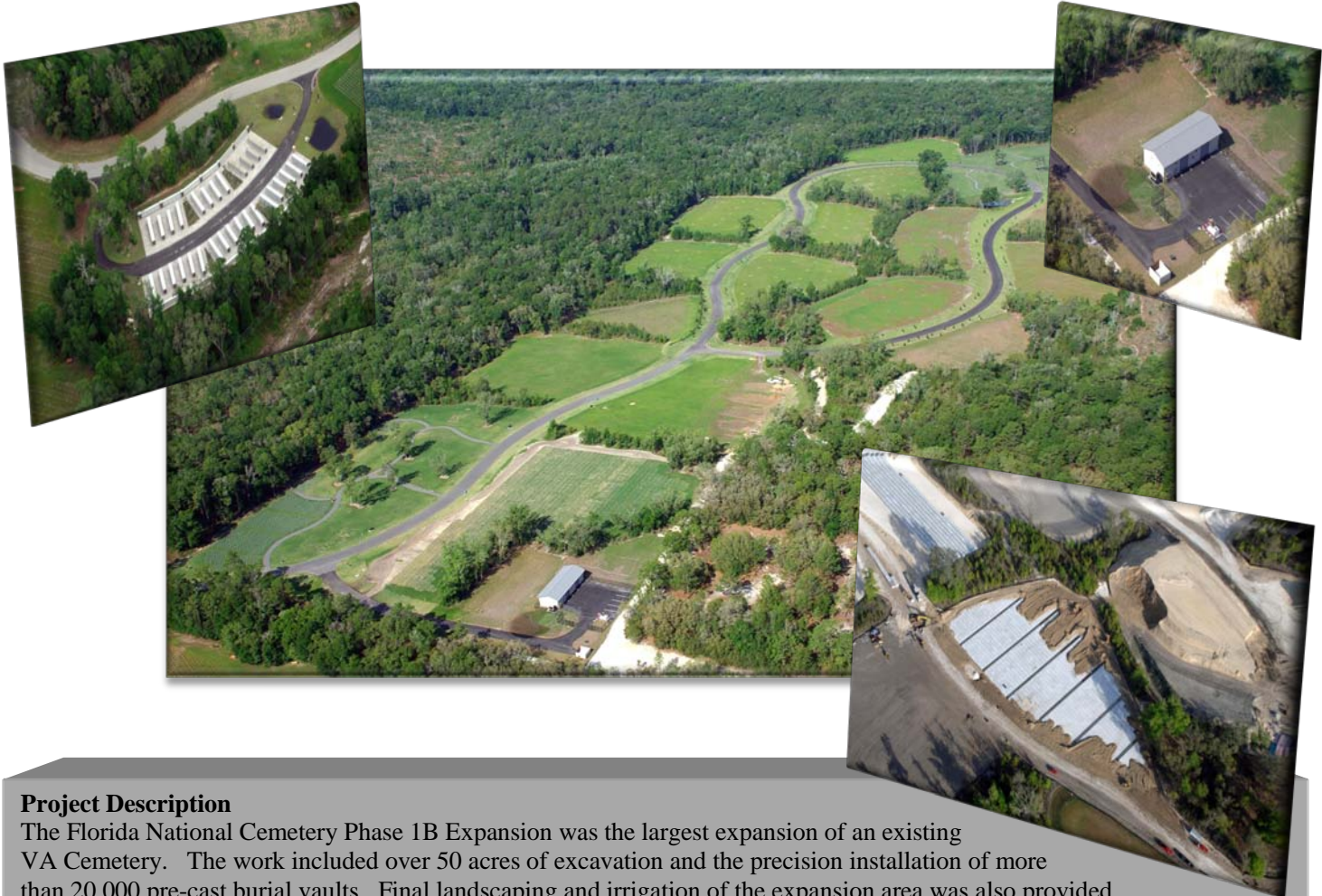


## Florida National Cemetery

### Project Description

The Florida National Cemetery Phase 1B Expansion was the largest expansion of an existing VA Cemetery. The work included over 50 acres of excavation and the precision installation of more than 20,000 pre-cast burial vaults. Final landscaping and irrigation of the expansion area was also provided. The work was performed while the original cemetery was actively providing internment services. Work was completed five (5) months ahead of schedule.

**Responsibility of QGS:** Cemetery Expansion Including Clearing, Earthwork, Drainage, Water, Sewer, Irrigation, Roads, Signage, Striping, Curb, Sidewalk, Grassing, Landscape, Restrooms, Security Booth, 20, 221 Crypts, 8,000 Columbaria Niches, 9,848 Conventional Gravesites, and 2 Committal Shelters.
