Project Description: The Lake Myrtle Sports Complex will be home to the Florida Youth Soccer Association and Russmatt Baseball, which holds collegiate baseball spring tournaments.

The complex will also house a mixed-use stadium and various other sports playing fields, where national and international competitions can be held.

The Florida Sports Hall of Fame will build its permanent museum at the complex. Offices for the Central Florida Economic Development Council and Polk County Tourism and Sports Marketing will be housed at the complex as well.

The complex will cover 275 acres on Lake Myrtle. County sports leaders say a water ski complex will eventually be built for tournaments. Other long-term goals include a

basketball complex, aquatics center, and a physical rehab center.

Responsibility of QGS: Complete Soccer Complex (9 soccer fields) including clearing, grading, drainage, water, sewer, storm, roads, curb, sidewalk, fencing, scoreboards, bleachers, pavilion, lighting, irrigation, and turf.
