Opened in 1996, George M. Steinbrenner Field is the Spring home of the New York Yankees, the full-time home of the Tampa Yankees (Single-A affiliate) and host to numerous other special events including concerts (i.e. Rod Stewart, Natalie Merchant, Moody Blues, Sting, Chicago, etc.), Florida State High School Championships, Preliminary Olympic Baseball and visits from President George W. Bush.

The Seating Capacity is 11,000+ total seats (Reserved Seating, Field Box's, Right Field Deck) and 13 Luxury Suites (each with a capacity of 20 guests)

174,661 fans attended the New York Yankees Spring Training Games in 2008 (15 games), the highest total among all Major League Baseball Teams. The Tampa Yankees average approximately 1,500 per game each summer.
